APPROVAL OF MINUTES

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Cory informed the Board that the Bureau, in conjunction with four other State agencies, will be purchasing a new licensing system. The Bureau will keep the Board informed on the process.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall presented the financial report, which shows a balance of \$125,266.35 as of April 30, 2012.

Ms. Peel presented a Stipulation and Consent Order for case number CHI-2012-1. It was moved by Dr. Nelson that the Board approve the Stipulation and Consent Order for case CHI-2012-1 and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Dr. Hollingsworth, motion carried.

Ms. Peel presented a Stipulation and Consent Order for case number CHI-2012-2. It was moved by Dr. Hollingsworth that the Board approve the Stipulation and

Consent Order for case CHI-2012-2 and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Dr. Nelson, motion carried.

Ms. Peel presented a Stipulation and Consent Order for case number CHI-2012-3. Dr. Anderson recused from discussion and Dr. Nelson stepped in as Chair. For Board Determination:

I-CHI-2012-8 and I-CHI-2012-9 – It was moved by Dr. White that the Board approve closure for cases I-CHI-2012-8 and I-CHI-2012-9. It was seconded by Dr. Nelson, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Dr. White researched and reported to the Board information on chiropractic assistants. The topic was discussed at the May 2012 Federal Chiropractor Licensing Boards meeting. The FCLB is working toward a certification program for chiropractic assistants. The program should be established in approximately six months and will be a model for any state that is looking to register chiropractic assistants. It was moved by Dr. Hollingsworth that Dr. White continues to research and contact the states that require certification for chiropractic assistants and send this information to the other Board members to review. This will be on the next meeting agenda for discussion. It was seconded by Dr. Nelson, motion carried.

Dr. Anderson researched whether other western state chiropractor boards allow chiropractors to offer discounts through similar programs and did not find any information. Dr. Hollingsworth suggested that Dr. Anderson send a letter to the chiropractor licensing boards requesting feedback on Groupon. The topic will be on the next agenda.
