Board reviewed the concerns that Mr. Hicks had in regards to the contract between the Board and the test center. The contract will be returned to board counsel for consideration of the changes suggested by Mr. Hicks.

The Board reviewed a request from Razzle Dazzle College of Hair Design to be allowed to utilize space in the same complex for the purpose of teaching theory. The space they have found does not share a roof or walls with the school. Moved by Mr. Hicks that Razzle Dazzle be advised that a separate classroom would be a separate school and must comply with licensure as per Idaho Code and Board rules. Seconded by Mr. Ulsh, carried.

The Board reviewed a request for information on the use of credo blades and pumice stones in the profession of nail technology. The Board expressed concern that the pumice stone would need to be sanitized between clients as required with any implement. Moved by Ms. Stutzke that the issue be referred to legal counsel for direction on the use of these implements and the compliance with other laws prior to response by the Board to the request for information. Seconded by Mr. Hicks, carried.
