

IDAHO BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY

July 2, 2001

Conference call commenced at 8:00 a.m. Roll call: Christy Stutzke, Patrick Ulsh,, Geneal Thompson, Eric Negaard. Bureau staff present: Tom Limbaugh, Budd Hetrick, John Kersey and Helen Piippo.

The Board discussed the frequency of the Esthetic exams. Motion by Mr. Ulsh to hold esthetic and electrology exams monthly effective 7-1-01. Seconded by Mr. Negaard. Motion carried.

Discussion held as to laser exams being given off-site for all written exams. Tabled until October Board meeting.

Discussion held on requiring mannequin hands for the nail technology exam. Motion by Mr. Ulsh that the office do the research and put in place for 2002 legislation to use mannequin hands for the nail technology exam and that a temporary rule to be able to use effective October 2001 board meeting. Seconded by Ms. Thompson. Motion carried.

The Board tabled discussion on contiguous licenses until additional information is available. Legislation may be considered for 2003.

The Board discussed having a central blood spill site at exams or taking the supplies to the applicant as needed. Mr. Ulsh made motion that a central blood spill area be set up at each exam. Seconded by Ms. Thompson. Motion carried.

Mr. Ulsh made motion to go into executive session to discuss examiners pending litigation. Seconded by Ms. Thompson. Motion carried.

Ms. Thompson made motion to come out of executive session. Seconded by Mr. Ulsh. Motion carried.

Ms. Thompson made motion to accept recommendation of Ms. Wallace for COS-B3B-01-01-007. Seconded by Mr. Ulsh. Motion carried. Ms. Stutzke and Mr. Negaard were recused from discussion and voting on issue. Mr. Kersey stated that a formal letter would be sent regarding the decision.

Ms. Stutzke gave update on the national meeting in Oklahoma City and asked about replacement for Mr. Limbaugh.

Mr. Negaard informed Board that the school owners have asked the board to consider reducing the 30-day application deadline, since work permits will no longer be issued. Discussion was held as to Rule 200 (01) and Rule 200 (02) a. Further discussion will be held on this.

There being no further discussion meeting was adjourned at 8:50 a.m.
