MEETING WITH PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

After discussing storm water management and the issues surrounding the qualified professionals that can provide this service, both Boards agreed to meet and work on a letter of understanding of common issues. The Landscape Architect Board agreed to write a first draft of the letter. This letter will include the date that the Landscape Architect and Engineer boards met and agreed-upon issues. The Engineer board will be meeting June 23rd and 24th and one of the Landscape Architect board members will attend. The letter of understanding, once signed by the Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and the Board of Landscape Architects, will provide scope-of-practice information to city officials.

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT
