The meeting was called to order at 8:04 AM MST by Gayla Nickel.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Ms. King made a motion to approve the minutes of 11/18/2013. It was seconded by Mr. Weston. Motion carried.

**FINANCIAL REPORT**

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Ms. Hacking gave a presentation on the changes being considered by the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards regarding the MBLEX exam, the FSTMB data bank, renewals, and continuing education. The Board discussed possible future changes regarding changing the hours of ethics required from one hour to three hours for the purpose of public safety. There was a discussion on fraud during examinations and steps that have been taken to rectify this issue.

Ms. Chatburn made a motion to not make any changes to the ethics requirements. Ms. Springer made a substitute to table the discussion concerning ethics. It was seconded by Ms. Chatburn. Motion Carried.

The Board discussed a letter from Ms. Beck regarding fieldwork versus externships/internships and different types of supervision, possible law and rule changes, and changes to the wording in the rule to clarify the definition on supervision of fieldwork versus internship/externship.

Mr. Hales presented the proposed rule changes for Rules 010, 503 (c and j), 600 (2.b), and the Code of Ethics Standard VI Prevention of Sexual Misconduct. No decisions were made. The Board will discuss these further at the next Board meeting.

Ms. Chatburn made a motion that Roger Hales make a draft and develop language that will meet the Boards goals regarding internship/externship. It was seconded by Ms. Springer. Motion carried.

The Board discussed students accepting compensation onsite in school. The Board's law does not allow compensation for students per Idaho Code 54-4003 (c).

Ms. Springer made a motion for Ms. King and Ms. Nickel to draft information to inform the public about compensation for students while attending school. The Board will review the draft at the next meeting, and then add it to the Boards frequently asked questions page on the website.

There was discussion regarding taking out the word "light" from Rule 503 (c) to be consistent with Idaho Code 54-4004 (3). No action was taken

The Board discussed adding a possible seven day application deadline to the rules. No further action was taken.

The Board had a discussion on therapeutic exercise. Ms. Chatburn will research therapeutic exercise to formulate and add the definitions to the Board's frequently asked questions page on the Board's website.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

The Board reviewed correspondence from Sue Phillips regarding teaching in massage school. The Board responded that she needs to read Rule 600- 2 (b) and Idaho Code 54-4003 (c). If she needs specific legal advice, she may need to seek private legal counsel for the specific situation.
