The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM MDT by Corwin Sutherin.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Davis-Martin made a motion to approve the minutes of 5/9/2013. It was seconded by Ms. DeAngelis. Motion carried.

Ms. Cory gave the legislative report.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall gave the financial report, which indicated that the Board has a cash balance of \$57,573.26 as of May 31, 2013.

NEW BUSINESS

PROPOSED LAW/RULE CHANGES

Mr. Hales stated that the law change regarding limited permits will go into effect as of July 1, 2013. This also required that the Board make changes in a Rule to comply with the law change. The Board reviewed the following prepared change to Rule .021.03:

c. A Limited Permit shall be valid ~~only until the person is granted or denied a license under Section 54-3710, Idaho Code, or until the results of the examination are available to the Board, whichever occurs first; provided however, a Limited Permit shall not be effective for more than six (6) months from the date of issue.~~ (3-29-10)

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d. A Limited Permit may ~~only be~~ extended by the Board for good cause ~~renewed once.~~ (1-5-88)

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Ms. Davis-Martin made a motion to approve the change as drafted and to submit it as a temporary proposed rule. It was seconded by Ms. DeAngelis. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION RE: THE CE REQUIREMENT

Following discussion of concerns pertaining to the current continuing education requirement in Board Rule .025, Ms. DeAngelis made a motion to form a sub-committee to review and propose any needed changes to its rules. It was seconded by Mr. Spero. Motion carried.

Mr. Spero made a motion to nominate Ms. DeAngelis and Ms. Davis-Martin as the sub-committee members. It was seconded by Ms. Magruder. Motion carried.

REVIEW CE AUDIT FORM

The Board discussed adding an additional requirement to CE Audit letters which would require a therapist who is utilizing either deep thermal, electrotherapeutic modalities, or wound care management to submit proof of training, as is required in the rules.

Ms. DeAngelis will review the revised form prior to sending it to licensees chosen for the annual random audits.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Ms. DeAngelis made a motion that the Board go into executive session under Idaho Code § 67-2345(1)(d) to consider records that are exempt from disclosure under the Idaho Public Records Law.
