The purpose of the conference call was for the adoption of temporary and proposed rules regarding licensure by endorsement. The Optometry Act was changed effective July 1, 1999 from licensure by reciprocity to licensure by endorsement. Therefore, there is a need for the Board to adopt by temporary and proposed rulemaking rules providing for licensure by endorsement.

The Board reviewed the draft of the proposed rules with one change being made in the new name of the international optometry organization being changed from the "International Association of Boards of Examiners in Optometry, Inc." to the "Association of Regulatory Boards of Optometry".

Moved by Dr. Matsuura, seconded by Dr. Vester and carried that the Board authorize the Bureau to proceed with promulgation of temporary and proposed rules regarding licensure by endorsement.
