Dear Education Provider:

The Idaho Board of Physical Therapy is now accepting the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy's **ProCert** certification for Continuing Education credit.

ProCert is a process that evaluates the continuing competence provided by courses. **ProCert** approved courses are accepted by many jurisdictions across the United States. Any provider of a physical therapy continuing competence activity registered as a Vendor in **aPTitude** may submit activity information to the online **ProCert** system. Registering and recording activities in **aPTitude** is free; however, there is a fee for **ProCert** certification. Submitting for **ProCert** certification is voluntary, but may be beneficial to providers of continuing competence activities for the following reasons:

- Renders that activity as recognized or acceptable by multiple jurisdiction boards as meeting those jurisdictions' licensure renewal requirements for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants;
- Promotes that activity as having met comprehensive standards for purposes of promoting the activity to prospective students and learners.
