The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM MDT by Stephanie A. Liddle.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Ohman made a motion to approve the minutes of 5/15/2012, 6/8/2012, and 6/25/2012. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Cory gave the legislative report.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall gave the financial report, which indicated that the Board has a cash balance of \$213,558.43 as of 7/13/2012.

FY 2013 RENEWAL CONTRACT

Ms. Hall presented the FY 2013 renewal contract to the members of the Board. Mr. White made a motion to approve the contract and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Mr. Ohman. Motion carried.

DISCIPLINE

Mr. Nelson presented a memorandum regarding case number PHT-2012-10. After discussion, the Board gave recommendations for appropriate discipline.

Discussion was also held regarding previous discipline with employment changes and what impact it would have on stipulation requirements.

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

Ms. Peel gave the investigative report, which is linked above.

FOR BOARD DETERMINATION

Ms. Fowers made a motion to approve the Bureau's recommendation and authorize closure in case I-PHT-2012-23. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Mr. White recused himself. Motion carried.

HEARING FOR BOARD RECONSIDERATION

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Mr. White that the Board go into executive session under Idaho Code § 67-2345(1)(d) to consider records that are exempt from disclosure under the Idaho Public Records Law. The purpose of the Executive Session was to consider license application materials. It was seconded by Mr. Ohman. OLD BUSINESS

DISCUSSION REGARDING BACKGROUND CHECKS

The Board further discussed implementing background checks as a requirement for new applicants for licensure. Ms. Cory stated she will follow up with the Idaho State Police to inquire how long they are valid for. The Board asked to move

forward with the proposal with the requirement that the background check be less than one (1) year old.

DISCUSSION REGARDING DIAGNOSTIC ULTRASOUND ~ FSBPT POSITION PAPER

The Board discussed adding ultrasound into either its law or rules. Because it's a scope of practice issue, Mr. Ohman stated he will discuss this with the Association.

Ms. Cory suggested the Board could also appoint a sub-committee to meet with Mr. Hales and look at its full set of laws and rules for any additional proposed changes to be made.

DISCUSSION REGARDING CODE OF ETHICS

The Board asked to table this discussion until after the annual meeting in September.

DISCUSSION REGARDING PROOF OF GRADUATION FOR EXAM APPLICANTS

Ms. Fowers made a motion to require the completed certificate of professional education form for new graduates prior to obtaining approval to register for the national examination. It was seconded by Mr. White. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION REGARDING CONTINUING COMPETANCE/APTITUDE

The Board asked to table this discussion until after the annual meeting in September.

The Board further discussed the aPTitude program for recording continuing education attendance. It was suggested that the Board could submit its article about this in the Association's newsletter. Mr. Ohman stated he will contact the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy (FSBPT) to inquire about the instructions they may have available for utilizing the program.

Mr. White made a motion to include information about the aPTitude program on the Board's website under the Frequently Asked Questions and Continuing Education Requirements links. It was seconded by Ms. Fowers. Motion carried.
