Board Meeting Minutes of 2/19/2016

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM MST by Brian White.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the minutes of 9/29/2015, 11/20/2015, and 12/8/2015. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Cory gave the legislative report. She reminded the Board of the due dates for any new proposed legislation.

Mr. Toryanski provided an update on the current proposed legislation regarding renewal and reinstatement fees. He said the Board will need to prepare proposed legislation to change the rules to match the law regarding fees for licensure renewal and reinstatement.

Mr. Ellsworth provided an update on the proposed legislation regarding IdaCare. He said it has passed unanimously in the House and has been heard in the Senate Commerce & Human Resources Committee. Mr. Ellsworth said this could be on the Senate agenda next week to be heard again. Ms. Cory reviewed the history and use of the IdaCare system (online license information for various health care professions). She said the Boards involved with IdaCare have their own websites where information within IdaCare is provided.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall gave the financial report, which indicated that the Board had a cash balance of \$248,089.81 as of 1/31/2016.

DISCIPLINE

Mr. Nelson presented a memorandum regarding case numbers PHT-2016-6, PHT-2016-5, and PHT-2016-7. Mr. White recused himself from case numbers PHT-2016-5 and PHT-2016-7. After discussion, the Board gave recommendations for appropriate discipline.

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

Ms. Peel gave the investigative report, which is linked above.

Ms. Peel provided a review of the reports provided in PHT-2015-1. No action was taken by the Board.

FOR BOARD DETERMINATION

Ms. Peel presented a consent order regarding case number PHT-2016-8. Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the Consent Order and allow the Board Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Ms. Lippiello. Motion carried.

Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the Bureau's recommendation and authorize closure in case I-PHT-2016-6. Mr. Mix recused himself from this case. It was seconded by Ms. Lippiello. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

To Do List – The Board reviewed the to do list and no action was taken.

DRY NEEDLING

Mr. White gave a report regarding the meeting between himself, Ms. Cory, and the Board Chairs of Acupuncture and Chiropractic Physicians. Ms. Cory discussed the background that prompted this meeting. The Board discussed dry needling as it relates to its scope of practice and that any legislation to add dry needling to the scope of practice for physical therapists would need to be proposed by the Idaho Physical Therapy Association.

LETTER TO COURSE PROVIDERS REGARDING PRO-CERT

The Board reviewed and made revisions to the letter to continuing education providers regarding Pro-Cert (provided through the Federation of State Boards of

Physical Therapy, FSBPT), and agreed to post it to its website and send to currently listed providers.

NEW BUSINESS

FEDERATION OF STATE BOARDS OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (FSBPT): FUTURE PRESENTATION ON aPTitude

The Board set two future meeting dates which Mr. Bailey will discuss with Heidi Herbst Paakkonen so she can provide a presentation to the Board regarding aPTitude, which is a continuing education tracking program for physical therapists provided through FSBPT.

FSBPT LICENSURE COMPACT

Mr. White gave an update to the Board regarding FSBPT's actions on its licensure compact. Ms. Cory discussed the licensure compacts that other Boards have been reviewing. She said she talked with Representative Rusche regarding the FSBPT licensure compact and that the Board may be bringing something to the 2017 Legislature. Mr. White will contact Mr. Lane at FSBPT, obtain the appropriate documentation, and Ms. Toncray will distribute it to the Board for its review prior to the next meeting.

FSBPT: LICENSEE LETTER FOR FAILED NATIONAL PHYSICAL THERAPY EXAMS (NPTE)

The Board reviewed the letter and made revisions. Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the letter to be sent to applicants who fail the NPTE. It was seconded by Mr. Mix. Motion carried.

FSBPT 2016 NPTE POLICIES

The Board reviewed the NPTE policies and asked Ms. Toncray to keep this resource in the Board books under "FSBPT Resources."

FSBPT SANCTIONS COMMITTEE/DISCIPLINARY GUIDELINES FOR JURISDICTIONS

The Board reviewed this FSBPT information and asked Ms. Toncray to also keep this in the Board books under "FSBPT Resources."

FSBPT 2016 BUDGET AND CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed the 2016 FSBPT budget and no action was taken.

The Board recommended that Mr. White, Mr. Mix, and Ms. Lippiello attend the Board Member & Administrator Regulatory Training in Alexandria, Virginia on June 24-26, 2016. The Board asked Ms. Toncray to contact FSBPT to see how many attendees they would fund; the FSBPT pays all expenses for this meeting.

The Board recommended that Mr. Mix (voting delegate) and Ms. Toncray attend the Annual FSBPT meeting in Columbus, Ohio on November 3-5, 2016. The Board reviewed the topics discussed at the Annual FSBPT meeting; FSBPT pays all expenses for this meeting.
