Board Meeting Minutes of 5/20/2016

The meeting was called to order at 9:03 AM MDT by Brian White.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the minutes of 2/19/2016, 3/8/2016, and 4/7/2016. It was seconded by Ms. Lippiello. Motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Cory gave the legislative report. She said that the IdaCare bill carried by Mr. Ellsworth passed, so licensees will no longer be required to update information on the IdaCare website after July 1, 2016. Mr. Ellsworth reviewed the IdaCare bill and noted that the Bureau provides license information and disciplinary actions on its website. Mr. Bailey made a motion to have Mr. White work with the Idaho Board of Medicine and other Boards on a letter to the affected licensees. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

Mr. Toryanski reviewed the proposed rules language which will be required to update the renewal and reinstatement rules and fees to line up with the laws passed in this Legislative Session. He also reviewed HB482 which was presented by the Governor's Office regarding Board member appointments.

Ms. Cory reminded the Board of the deadlines regarding laws and rules for the 2017 Legislative Session. The Board discussed dry needling and physiotherapy. Any change to a profession's scope of practice would require the association to work on a legislative change.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall gave the financial report, which indicated that the Board had a cash balance of \$247,887.50 as of 4/30/2016.

DISCIPLINE

Mr. Nelson presented a memorandum regarding case numbers PHT-2016-2, and PHT-2016-12. After discussion, the Board gave recommendations for appropriate discipline.

Mr. Nelson presented a Stipulation and Consent Order in cases PHT-2016-1, PHT-2016-3, PHT-2016-4, PHT-2016-6, and PHT-2016-7. Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the Consent Orders and allow the Board Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

Ms. Peel gave the investigative report, which is linked above.

Ms. Lippiello made a motion to approve the Bureau's recommendation and authorize closure in case I-PHT-2016-9. It was seconded by Mr. Bailey. Motion carried.

Ms. Peel presented a Settlement Order in case PHT-2016-10. Mr. Mix made a motion to accept the Settlement Order and allow the Board Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Mr. Bailey. Motion carried.

Ms. Peel presented a letter for a proposed auditor in case PHT-2015-3. Mr. Mix made a motion to deny the proposed auditor and have Respondent select an unrelated, unbiased party with no present or past business relationships to Respondent, and have the Board Chair approve the selected party on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Mr. Bailey. Motion carried.

FEDERATION OF STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (FSBPT) LICENSURE COMPACT

Ms. Cory provided a summary of the recent history regarding the FSBPT Licensure Compact. Mr. Ellsworth said the Compact provides permission for FSBPT to override the laws and rules in the states which agree to the Compact. The Board discussed the FSBPT Licensure Compact and no action was taken.

Ms. Herbst Paakkonen with the FSBPT reviewed aPTitude and ProCert with the Board. The Board discussed the optional use of aPTitude and ProCert.
