The meeting was called to order at 9:05 AM MDT by Ms. Cory.

Ms. Lippiello made a motion to nominate Mr. Bailey to be the Acting Chair. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Lippiello made a motion to approve the minutes of 7/17/2017, 9/5/2017, and 9/27/2017. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Cory gave the legislative report. The deadlines to submit proposed law and rule changes to the Governor's Office have passed for the 2018 Legislative Session. She said the deadlines for the 2019 Legislative Session are mid-July 2019 for any proposed laws and the third week in August for any proposed rules.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Ms. Hall gave the financial report, which indicated that the Board had a cash balance of \$244,235.94 as of 9/30/2017.

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

Ms. Peel gave the investigative report, which is linked above.

Ms. Peel presented a Payment Proposal and Stipulation and Consent Order in case PHT-2016-9. Ms. Lippiello made a motion to approve the Payment Proposal.

It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried. Ms. Lippiello made a motion to approve the Stipulation and Consent Order in case PHT-2016-9 and to allow Respondent to complete probation in Utah with an auditor approved by the Board reviewing the notes completed for patients seen by Respondent in Utah as long as Respondent remains in compliance with the Order while residing in Utah. It was seconded by Ms. Schroeder. Motion carried.

Ms. Peel reviewed the monthly reports for cases PHT-2015-1 and PHT 2015-3.

OLD BUSINESS

To Do List – The Board reviewed the to do list and no action was taken.

NOTIFICATION TO LICENSEES/PROPOSED RULES

The Board reviewed the notification sent to licensees regarding the proposed rules and no action was taken.

Mr. Nelson presented a memorandum regarding case numbers PHT-2018-1. After discussion, the Board gave recommendations for appropriate discipline.

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Ms. Cory reviewed the Executive Order issued by Acting Governor Little which requires State agencies to submit a report to the Office of the Governor no later than July 1, 2018. The report will assess whether the licensure requirements are necessary and in the public interest while providing recommendations for improvement, modification or elimination. Ms. Cory updated the Board about the meeting with Lt. Governor Little on 10/12/2017. She also updated the Board on the information and process for public comment which has been added to the Board's website. She said Mr. White will continue to work with her and Ms. Callahan on this project.

NEW BUSINESS

FEDERATION OF STATE BOARDS OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (FSBPT) 2018 DUES

Mr. Mix made a motion to approve payment of the 2018 FSBPT dues. It was seconded by Ms. Lippiello. Motion carried.

PROPOSED RULES – COMMENT

The Board reviewed a comment regarding the proposed rule regarding the requirement of the number of continuing education hours for licenses expired for one year (16 hours), two years (32 hours), and more than two years (48 hours). The Board discussed the comment and agreed that the correspondent needs to clarify her questions regarding inactive status and let the Board know if she would like to see an inactive status license provided within the Board's laws. Mr. Mix made a motion to have Ms. Toncray work with Ms. Callahan to draft a response letter to the licensee regarding the proposed rule, thanking her for her interest, re-explaining the proposed changes, asking her to clarify her questions regarding inactive status licensure, provide the website for the Executive Order, and have the Chair review and sign it. It was seconded by Ms. Lippiello. Motion carried.
